## YAHSHUA ROAD - THE GAME

This game explores in a playful way, how to walk on the Narrow Road (Yahshua Road) from sunrise to sunset.

With real-life situations, insightful tips, prayers, and inspirational Bible verses, the players will receive a deeper understanding of what it means to be a follower of Jesus (Yahshua עֵשׂוּרָה) Christ.

The purpose of this game is to plant seeds in the hearts of the players. Seeds that will become fruits and work as reminders when help is needed.

# GAME RULES & INSTRUCTIONS

## CONTENTS

1 Game board, 83 cards, 1 booklet, 4 Pawns, 1 die.

## SETTING UP THE GAME

- Place the game board in the center of the playing area.
- Each player chooses a pawn.
- Separate the cards by category (Super Weapon, Stumbling Blocks, Check Yourself, Check Your Eye + Ear + Mouth Gate, Let's Laugh Action + Tongue Twister) and place them face down near the game board.

## PLAYING THE GAME

- Roll a 1 or a 3 to start the game.
- Roll the die and move your pawn the number of spaces rolled on your turn.
- If your pawn lands on a space with a symbol or number, refer to the section below to know what to do next.

## SYMBOLS & NUMBERS



**START** - The sun is rising. Time to get up and ready for the day.

- Roll a 1 or 3 to start the game.



**SUPER WEAPON** - Each day comes with its own challenges.

- The Super Weapon cards are suggestions on how to deal with those challenges, in a way that pleases God.

After reading the Super Weapon card, place it back randomly in its pile.



**STUMBLING BLOCKS** - A day is usually filled with big and small obstacles.

- Take a Stumbling Blocks card. Read the text aloud and answer the question with your own words. You may also read the answer on the corresponding Super Weapon card.

For example: if you took the Stumbling Blocks card Number 12, the corresponding answer will be on the Super Weapon card Number 12.

Then, place the cards back randomly in their respective piles.



**CHECK YOURSELF** - We do many things unconsciously throughout the day. Yet we should learn to be fully aware of what we do.

- Take a Check Yourself card. Read the text aloud and answer the question with your own words. You may also read the answer on the corresponding Super Weapon card.

For example: If you took the Check Yourself card Number 18, the corresponding answer will be on the Super Weapon card Number 18.

Then, place the cards back randomly in their respective piles.



**CHECK YOUR GATE** - The Bible refers in 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 to the followers of Christ as being God's temple. Are you fully aware of what enters into your temple throughout the day?

→ Take a Check Your Gate card (you will either take the ear, eye or mouth card depending on where your pawn is) and read the text aloud. If applicable, answer the question then read the additional info written on the back of the card.

Then, place the card back randomly in its pile.



**TIME OUT** - It's time to take a break from the busy world. Find a place where you will be undisturbed. No phone, no iPad, no TV, etc... Spend some time in God's presence or converse with Jesus.

→ You won't play for one playing round.



**LET'S LAUGH** - Laughter is powerful. Laughter is good. Let's take it easy from time to time and allow joy to arise in our hearts.

→ Take a Let's Laugh card. You will either do a simple funny action or read a tongue twister aloud.

Then, place the card back randomly in its pile.

+ 2 → move 2 cases forward.

- 2 → move 2 cases back.

+ 4 → move 4 cases forward.

- 4 → move 4 cases back.



**THE WINNER** - The sun has set. You did your best. It's time to rest.

→ Congratulations! You've reached the moon symbol and won the game. Hopefully some valuable things were learned today.

*Note: with three or four players, the game is over when at least two players have reached the moon symbol.*
