"Some of them believe I don't even exist."


A single tear trickled down Father God's cheek.

"Father, your prophets have told them how much you love them and that you can help them, no matter what problem they are facing."


Jesus thought for a moment in silence and then continued.

"Oh, my Son, my heart is now rejoicing! I will send you. Whoever listens to you and repents of their sins, will be forgiven."




"And we will build them beautiful homes where they can live with us forever."

"You will die a painful death on a cross."


"I must go through pain so their pain can be taken away, and I must be nailed to a cross so their sins can be nailed to the cross."
